#### SHUTTLE SERVICE

A shuttle service will available to all patrons parking in the General Admission shuttle/overflow lot (enter from Gates 1 or 2, Highway 75). There will be drop-offs at key points throughout the perimeter of the racecourse with stops at Club House Turn, two along Valley View and one convenient to the Meadows, Wither, Crest and Old Hilltop. Each shuttle pass, sold on race day, is \$5 round trip per person. Children sitting in the lap of an adult ride free.

#### ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Important things to bring along with you on race day check list:

- Don't forget to bring your CAR PASS. ALL OCCUPANTS MUST HAVE A BADGE, except children under 12.

  PLEASE BE PREPARED TO DISPLAY ALL PASSES UPON ENTRY AT THE GATE.
- If your reservation category is on Member's Hill, Club House Turn or the Paddock, please be aware that ALL mobile children must be wearing an appropriate badge allowing them access into those two categories. General Admission Badges will be sold at the gate on race day, however, please note that they increase to \$30.00 a person. General Admission tickets may also be purchased in advance using your VIC card for a \$2.00 discount at all area Harris Teeter stores throughout the Charlotte region.
- Sun tan lotion, and lots of it!
- Hats, and if homemade, hand decorated or tastefully unique, may also be entered into the Hat Contest
- Binoculars to see some racing action after all that's why we're here. Right?
- ❖ Tables, chairs, table cloths, eating utensils, flower arrangements, friends, lunch and dessert. NO THIRD PARTY VENDORS OR DROP-OFFS PERMITTED. Please contact our Queen's Cup Official Vendors for your tailgating needs.

- Loud music, flags, banners, flyers or solicitation material (disturbs the horses, sponsors and others around you)
